In April 2008, the Office of Program Policy Analysis & Government Accountability (OPPAGA) released Report Number 08-27, *Responsibility for the Education of Exceptional Students in Residential Treatment Facilities Needs Clarification*. This report examines financial responsibility for educational services provided to exceptional students in residential treatment facilities.

Florida statute requires that the Office of the Inspector General conduct a six-month follow-up for all OPPAGA and Auditor General Reports. Since there were no specific recommendations or corrective action requests from OPPAGA for the Department of Juvenile Justice, we have determined that no follow-up activity is warranted.
