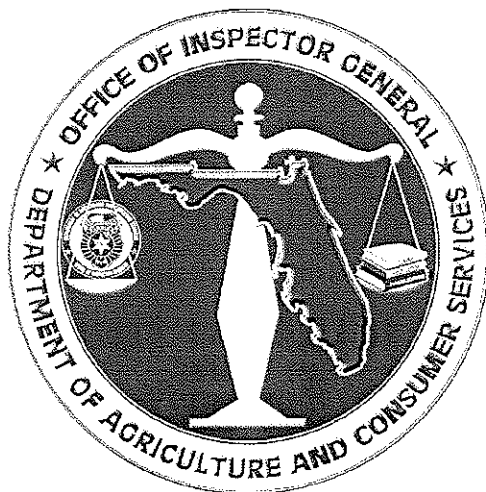

**Compliance and Internal Controls Over Financial Reporting and  
Federal Awards for the Fiscal Year Ended June 30, 2010**

The Inspector General is required by Florida Statute 20.055(5)(h) to report to the Commissioner of Agriculture on the status of corrective actions taken on reports published by the Auditor General or the Office of Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability (OPPAGA).

### Summary of Auditor General Audit

As a condition of receiving Federal funds, the U.S. Office of Management and Budget (OMB) requires, as described in OMB Circular A-133, an audit of major Federal awards programs. The State's compliance with governing requirements for the Federal awards programs or program clusters identified as major programs for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2010, were audited.

The Auditor General selected the Child Nutrition Cluster as the Federal Awards program audited for fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. This audit contained no findings and recommendations that required corrective action by the Department; however, there was one finding for the Department of Education regarding deficiencies in access security controls.

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
